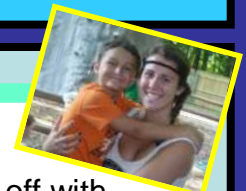

CANOLLI FILLING

- ½ cup chocolate chips



Chill and use mixture to fill store-bought canolli shells (recipe is enough to fill about 12 shells)

- Peel and mash 2 avocados
- Stir in 1 clove minced garlic, 1 chopped tomato, juice of one lime
- Add salt and pepper to taste
- Chill for 30 minutes; serve with tortilla chips

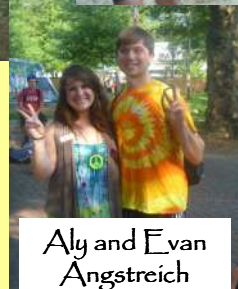

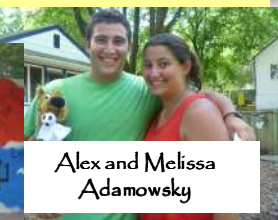
