Once again led by Gene, our pool crew of Melissa, Lenny, Arielle, Ariel, Rebecca, Lauren, Matthew, Jeff, Amy and Emily, are busily teaching breathing, front crawl, bubbles, butterfly and all of the other critical swimming **skills** and **strokes**. Our campers then get to show off their new skills at afternoon recreational swim. As a note to first year families (and a reminder to returning families), we have divided the Red Cross levels into LakeView sub-levels to ensure that we are really teaching and tracking our campers' progress.
