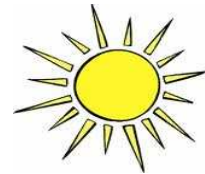
WEEK TWO ... WOO HOO!!

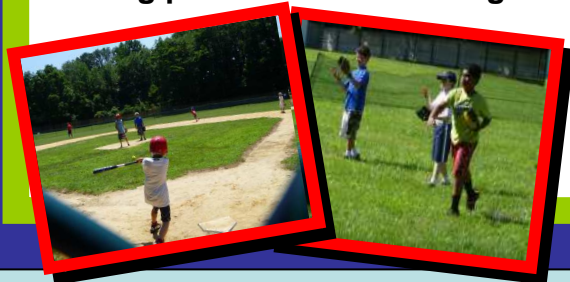
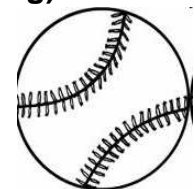

Applesauce Cookies

Stir together:

- 3 ½ cups flour
- 1 tsp. baking powder and 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp. cinnamon and 1 tsp. cloves

Cream together:

- 1 cup margarine or softened butter
- 1 ½ cups brown sugar
- Beat in 1 ½ cups unsweetened applesauce, then beat in flour mixture until well blended

Drop by teaspoonfuls onto greased cookie sheet, and bake at 375 for 12-15 minutes.

And "Ich Liebe LVDC!!" (I love LVDC!!)

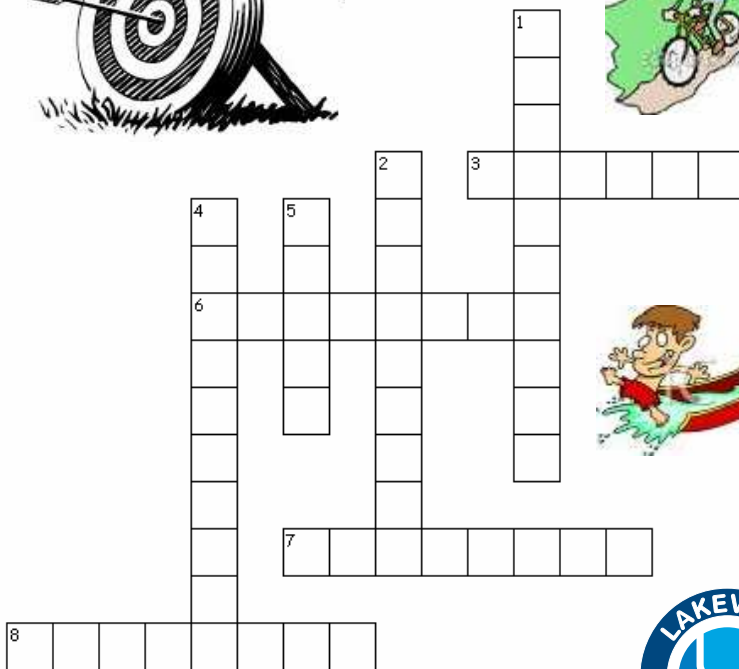

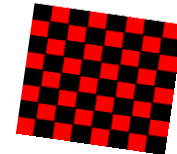
