- If you receive a missed call from camp during the day, **please be sure to check your voicemail before you call us back if you can.** There are lots of reasons we might be calling you - to ask a question, tell you about something fantastic your camper did, or to follow up with you. And there are many different people who could be calling you; we only know where to direct your call if you've checked to see whose call you're returning.
- Please be sure to **check your camper's backpack** each night after camp. We periodically send home information, messages and permission slips for overnights and other activities, and this is the best way to get things to you during the summer!
- PLEASE** have your camper ready at their scheduled morning bus pickup time, preferably waiting outside, as a courtesy to other camp families. We allocate just a few minutes for your camper to give you a quick goodbye kiss and hop onto the bus to get buckled in. When a camper isn't ready when the bus arrives, it can slow down the route. We don't want our campers to miss even a minute of LakeView fun!
