LakeView Sports League Update

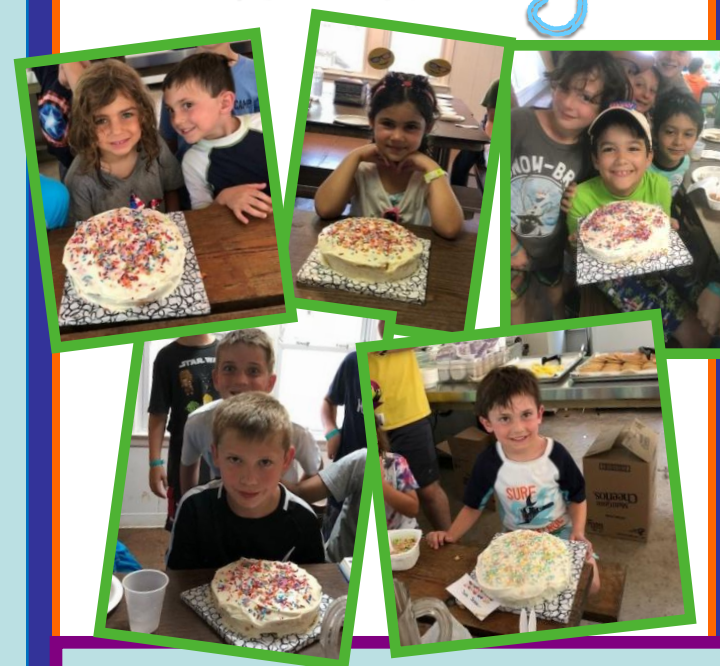
